

SPECIFICATION / QUOTATION SHEET COMPLETION INSTRUCTIONS

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- ↯ There is a separate Specification/Quotation sheet for each product. Click on relevant link to download a copy of the required form, which will detail the standard build options available.
- ↯ Fields shaded blue indicate information required by us to process/complete your order.
- ↯ The Specification Sheet shows the options available by a brief description with code numbers or letters which are shown in red. By entering these numbers or letters in the blue fields on the right hand side of the sheet - a product code is created which becomes the unique identifier for the product you require.
- ↯ Please be aware that choosing certain options may limit your choices in other option categories (for example, six bulbs are not available on a three bulb lamp array). Where practical a comment box detailing these limitations will be shown.
- ↯ On some specification sheets a 'tick' may be found. This should be transferred to the blue field to the right of the required option using the excel 'cut & paste' function.
- ↯ Once completed use the 'save as' function to save the file to your computer (Please ensure all blue shaded fields are filled before saving) and attach the file to an e-mail and send to sales@starpoint.uk.com.

REEL MECHANISMS & GAMING DEVICES

- ↯ **Lamp array pointer position:** Three numbers are required in this field which tells us what angle you wish the lamp array pointer position to be set. Please remember the lamp array pointer faces in the opposite direction to the lamp array. You should also consider if your mechanism will be cabinet or glass mounted.
- ↯ **Top lamp position:** If your reel mechanism is illuminated, this question determines the order in which the bulbs will be fitted to the lamp array and allows you to specify whether you require the lamp at the top of your illumination (top lamp), to be fitted at the end of the lamp array marked '+' or the end marked '-' (see illustration at the top of the sheet).

PUSH BUTTONS

- ↯ **Inserts:** If you require Starpoint to fit Inserts (either Starpoint Manufactured or supplied by you) our standard build will be to snap the Lens Cap into position. If we are not supplying Inserts then our Standard build will be to supply Lens Caps loose.
